From Model to Role Model

Growing up in the suburbs of Portland, Oregon, in close-knit Italian family, Murphy always knew she had an affinity for the entertainment industry. With a grandmother who was a model and singer and a musician uncle, engaging others was in her blood. Having begged her mother for years to do what she loved, she began attending a local modeling and acting school, honing her ability on camera and on stage. Chosen to represent her school at the city's legendary Rose Festival, she felt naturally at ease commanding an audience in front of hundreds of her classmates.

Represented by the local agency ABC Kids, Murphy had the opportunity at the tender age of 20 to work on the other side of the desk. By 27, she had purchased—and was running—the now renamed Murphy Talent Group. While building one of the most respected agencies in the Northwest, Murphy broke the status quo by still appearing in on-air gigs. Nonetheless, she found she was also a natural at finding and developing talent in others.

Life Lessons

By 2008, Murphy was appearing as a new reality host on the Golf Channel, and was a "MADE" coach on the popular MTV show. Meanwhile, the Murphy Talent Group had grown over 400%. But fate had something else in store for her. The recession hit, and she was forced to file for bankruptcy. Heartbroken at the loss, she nonetheless took away the valuable lesson of surrounding herself with mentors—a lesson she would eventually use to launch her most successful venture yet.

Murphy began a new chapter in her life by moving to Los Angeles to pursue her dream of becoming the next Mary Hart. Hosting gigs on E! and red carpet premieres soon followed. Still auditioning for roles, she had a "light bulb" moment while cooling her heels for three hours in a waiting room. Instead of waiting for opportunity, Murphy realized she was primed to create it—for herself and for others, and soon afterwards

By now, she'd learned to always say "yes" to opportunity.
